If you answered **YES** to either of the last 2 questions, we **cannot** accept your car seat.

TRAVEL SYSTEMS: If you have a car seat/stroller system and your car seat does not meet these safety standards, consider selling the stroller at the sale and disposing of the car seat. Strollers sell very well and you won't have to worry about the safety of any child in regards to the car seat.
